Dear Participant

We are sending this letter to you because you are a participant in the Seafarers Health and Benefits Plan ("Plan"). The Plan provide benefits to employees of signatory maritime employers who have collective bargaining agreements with the Seafarers International Union, Atlantic, Gulf, Lakes and Inland Waters or an affiliated Union. You may be eligible for benefits now or may become eligible for benefits in the future from the Seafarers Health and Benefits Plan.

Enclosed is important information regarding your benefits. The same information is available online at www.seafarers.org, which is immediately updated whenever there is a change in your benefits. The following are brief summaries of the plan documents enclosed with this letter:

- Seafarers Benefit Plans Electronic Consent Form Complete and return if you want to receive certain non-confidential documents electronically, instead of by mail.
- Seafarers Benefit Plans Beneficiary Form Complete and return if you want to designate someone to receive a benefit in the event of your death for your eligible Plan(s).

After you work for 90 days in covered employment, with less than a 90-day break between jobs, you will become eligible for health care benefits from the Seafarers Health and Benefits Plan. Upon your eligibility, the Plans provide you with more information about your health benefits. The information will be mailed to you if you have not consented to electronic delivery.

You can also register for a Member Portal Account online at www.seafarers.org. The portal gives you access to update your contact information, view your dues history, enables you to view results of your physical exams, and allows you to request various services such as physical exams and drug tests.
